- *Geodis*, comprising six business lines (freight management, groupage and express, contract logistics, full- and part-load road transport, logistics and transport of finished vehicles, management and optimisation of the supply chain)
- *Freight transport by rail* (rail companies, combined transport and rail services)
- *Asset management* (long-term leasing of wagons, tankers, containers and train engines)

At this event, SNCF Geodis wishes to show how its global offering, based on synergies between solutions and resources and dedicated to transport and logistics, is able to deliver integrated services meeting the needs of each market sector. Designed to generate added value at each link in the supply chain, these services are backed up by a practical approach focused on customer satisfaction and the optimisation of their logistics flows.
